JOB POSTING: Audio Visual Technician

Central Congregational United Church of Christ is seeking a part-time on-site Audio Visual Technician (AVT) ~3-4 hours per week:

Snapshot:

- ✓ Manage the AV needs of one weekly Sunday morning service that includes live worship in church plus simultaneous live video conference via Zoom and live stream on YouTube plus recording service for later editing and posting
- ✓ *Sundays 10:15 am - 1:00 pm inclusive of set up, service, and breakdown, and editing/posting of service and sermon.*
- ✓ *Option to expand hours through occasional special worship services and events as your schedule permits on evenings and weekends plus other communication/media/web related project work based on skill set and experience.*

Overview:

Our sanctuary provides a breathtaking view of our nature preserve and the changing seasons to complement the visual offering you will be making. The AVT will be a key support for the worship life of the church. We currently use a Behringer X-air audio system, a Roland V8-HD video switcher, and three PTZ cameras to record and stream our services to Youtube and Zoom.

Our Sunday worship service includes several speakers, choral, and instrumental elements. Proficiency in quickly adjusting audio and camera settings to match the moment is vital. The ability to work with various speakers and artists is key. We have ~100 regular attenders in person and via online streaming platforms each Sunday.

Central Congregational Church has been on rock solid ground for almost 150 years, but we haven't left our thinking in the 1800s. We celebrate an open and progressive Christian theology, and the UCC denomination is deeply committed to social justice, peace advocacy and leadership roles for ALL!

Primary Duties:

1. Ensure that the AV system is turned on and fully operational before the worship service begins.
2. Ensure that microphones are properly placed and in working condition for the needs of each service.
3. Manage the production and live broadcasting of worship services, which includes recording services for later editing.
4. Edit live recordings of each service and upload the full service and sermon to Youtube and other streaming platforms.
5. Arrive promptly at 10:15 am each Sunday morning.
6. Provide support for special services (e.g., Ash Wednesday, Maundy Thursday, and Christmas Eve), based on your availability.
7. Provide support for non-church special events hosted at Central (weddings, funerals, meetings, etc), based on your availability. There are normally no more than 12 such events each year. They are usually scheduled on Thursdays, Saturdays, and/or Sunday afternoons. Other duties as assigned.

Qualifications:

- Knowledge of and experience with audio mixing equipment, especially Behringer X-Air systems
- Knowledge of and experience with video recording equipment, especially Roland V-8HD video switcher and VMS software.
- Experience with ADJ DMX operator controller (lighting) a plus
- Experience working with Zoom video conferencing platform and YouTube
- Ability to work with staff and volunteers, while being open to direction and constructive feedback
- Demonstrate exceptional organizational and time management skills;
- Ability to maintain a professional demeanor in a live production environment,
- Desire to ensure a good AV experience for worship participants - bring ideas, provide feedback to staff on ways to improve and enhance
- Be a dependable and flexible team participant
